

The Recipient of the Honorary Degree

EDWARD A. HOBART

Doctor of Science

Engineer of unusual capabilities, scientist, inventor, industrial organizer, civic leader, and one of the great pioneers of the welding industry

Edward A. Hobart, President and Chairman of the Board of the Hobart Brothers Company of Troy, Ohio, has made the Hobart name synonymous with industrial progress. The pioneering work he did as a young man resulted in 34 significant patents and formed a basis for products and product development for the new company which he founded with his brother.

In World War II, he served his country in the development of portable welding equipment, power units for anti-aircraft gun placements, radar power units as well as power units for the Early Warning Radar line. As the aviation industry grew, mobile ground power equipment was needed, first for internal engines and then for jet engines. Mr. Hobart's leadership and his work insured that such equipment was developed.

The welding field captured Mr. Hobart's principle interest, and with his associates, he devoted his attention to the task of advancing this new field. Soon he realized that if the industry were to grow it would require not only equipment to obtain the welding arc but also new kinds of electrodes. The Korean War, however, caused a shortage of rutile, a basic component of electrode manufacturing. Mr. Hobart's response was to develop a process for the separation of rutile from Florida sands, work for which he was awarded three patents and from which evolved a new mining venture which he helped to organize. Today, because of his efforts, the United States is independent of overseas sources of rutile, a material useful in many industries.

A shortage of welding operators prompted him to begin a trade school which later grew into a modern technical institute. As the Hobart organization expanded, he designed and constructed its facilities. The influx of many new people to local industry created a shortage of suitable housing and recreational facilities in the small town of Troy. Mr. Hobart personally developed several subdivisions which provided more than one thousand homes in pleasant surroundings and assisted in the development of public parks, a stadium, and other recreational facilities valued at more than one million dollars.

Edward A. Hobart has been quick to identify the challenges facing our country and has responded creatively to meet the problems of change with effective solutions. The Ohio State University is privileged to honor this distinguished alumnus for his many contributions to his fellow man.

The American Council on Education, through the cooperation of its institutional members, has established the Academic Costume Code, which has been adopted almost completely by institutions of higher learning in this country. The following information is provided for the benefit of visitors to academic ceremonies at The Ohio State University.

THE GOWN

Bachelor

Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master

Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor

Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

THE HOOD

Bachelor

Three feet in length with a two-inch wide velvet.*

Master

Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch wide velvet.*

Doctor

Four feet in length with a five-inch wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet on all hoods indicates the field of study as follows:
