Simon Dinitz

A professor of sociology who is considered one of the foremost criminologists in the world today, Simon Dinitz has been honored repeatedly by his peers for his influential research in mental illness, crime, juvenile delinquency, and violent behavior. His book on schizophrenia, one of 14 he has written, is credited with the movement which brought schizophrenics out of mental hospitals and into functional lives in the community. It was for this work that he was awarded the 1967 Hofheimer Prize for Research from the American Psychiatric Association.

More recently Dr. Dinitz became the first Ohio State professor to have won both the University's Alumni Award for Distinguished Teaching (1970) and its

Distinguished Research Award (1979). Nominations for these awards are made by students and professional colleagues and reflect the high regard of the entire academic community.

Dr. Dinitz is a native of New York City and received the bachelor of arts degree, magna cum laude, from Vanderbilt University in 1947. He received the master of arts in 1949 and the Ph.D. in 1951, both from the University of Wisconsin. He has been a faculty member at Ohio State since 1951.

His accomplishments exemplify the scholarly excellence of the University's faculty and their dedication to the University's mission of teaching, research, and service. The Ohio State University is honored to have Simon Dinitz address the graduates of the 278th Commencement.



Recipients of Honors

Merritt Madison Chambers Doctor of Humane Letters

A longstanding and ardent supporter of public higher education, M. M. Chambers has been teaching and doing scholarly research for more than a half-century. He has been the mentor of thousands of students. In the course of his distinguished career, he has written 35 books and monographs and some 400 published articles. Known for his expertise in higher education finance and law, he has, for nearly 25 years, collected, analyzed, and circulated statistics on support by the fifty states for higher education. His staunch advocacy of public higher education is best expressed by one of his often-quoted statements: "The public value of universal access to higher education is incalculable. It is the most productive possible long-term investment for public funds, for dollar return, and for the intangible benefits to society." The Ohio State University is pleased to honor its alumnus, Merritt Madison Chambers, for his invaluable contributions to public higher education.

As professor emeritus, he organized the Alumni Marching Band, a group unique to the annals of college marching bands. Alumni throughout this country and Europe are a tribute to the excellence of this widely respected scholar and teacher. For one who has given so much to the University, it is fitting that Ohio State now sings his praises.

John A. Prior Distinguished Service Award

The medical career of Dr. John A. Prior has brought honor and credit both to himself and to this University. An alumnus of this institution, he provided academic and administrative leadership to the College of Medicine for more than 40 years. Serving in the ranks from instructor to director of the Pulmonary Disease Division to dean of the College of Medicine, Dr. Prior through his expertise has given strength to the medical program here. Others as well have recognized his contributions to Ohio State. The recipient of a University Distinguished Teaching Award and an Alumni Achievement Award, he was also voted Man of the Year in the College of Medicine. Through his scientific publications and other writings, he has advanced the study of medicine far beyond this institution. Ohio State University has been well served by the contributions of this noted physician.

Jack O. Evans Distinguished Service Award

The hearts of Ohio State University's friends have thrilled as Jack O. Evans filled this campus with music. As director of the University's Activities Band, the Buckeye Scarlet Band, Military and Marching Band, he has kindled the friendship and spirit that are Ohio State. As professor of trombone, he is known throughout the country as a distinguished teacher. During his many years of service, his dedication to this institution has continued to grow. Even after retirement, he has sought out and counseled students who have become part of the Ohio State musical tradition.

To you, your families, friends, and those others who helped you arrive here today go our congratulations. You are joining a great family of Ohio State alumni working together to make a difference.





The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square — a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet.*

Master Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet.*

Doctor Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:
