Erwin E. Dreese



The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well. and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained largely drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square-a shape which ballad folklore suggests resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave: the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but is lined with the official colors of the University.

THE GOWN

Bachelor

Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master

Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor

Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

THE HOOD

Bachelor

Three feet in length with a two-inch wide velvet.*

Master

Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch wide velvet.*

Doctor

Four feet in length with a five-inch wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:

Candidates for degrees at The Ohio State University wear the black mortarboard with a tassel the color of which is distinctive of the degree being received. The tassel colors are as follows:



Recognized today as having the largest enrollment of any university campus in the country, The Ohio State University began with 24 students meeting on the Neil farm in 1873. At this site the Columbus Campus now extends over 3,300 acres, where 345 permanent buildings meet the academic needs of 47,000 students.

Originally chartered as the Ohio Agricultural and Mechanical College in 1870, the school was officially renamed The Ohio State University in 1878. That year also marked the graduation of the first class, with the first master's degree awarded in 1886 and the first doctorate in 1890.

Burgeoning enrollment and expanded academic programs have necessitated administrative reorganization through the years. In 1896, the seven independent Colleges of Agriculture, Arts, Philosophy and Science, Engineering, Law, Pharmacy, and Veterinary Medicine were established. By 1912, the Graduate School was in operation, and a year later, the Colleges of Medicine and Dentistry were authorized. The College of Arts and Sciences, established in 1930, is now a federation of five colleges representing specialized fields of endeavor in the arts, biological sciences, humanities, physical sciences, and social sciences. In 1957 the University made higher education more readily available to all Ohioans by creating regional campuses at Newark and Marion. More recently, regional campuses were added in Lima and Mansfield. Ohio State is now comprised of 16 colleges and a graduate school, which offer more than 250 programs of study and approximately 7,800 courses. As the major center for graduate study and professional education in Ohio, the University awards the master's degree in 114 study areas and the doctoral degree in 83 disciplines.
